PERMIT TO CLEAR LAND, CONSTRUCT DOCKS AND/OR WITHDRAW WATER
ON/FROM LAKE RABON**

Tax ID #: _____ which joins property of the Laurens County Water and Sewer Commission's (LCWSC) LAKE RABON at the 545.0 ft. above Mean Sea Level (MSL) contour line, hereby make application to the LCWSC for a Permit for the following on/from LAKE RABON (Please check):

- ERECT DOCK OR WALKWAY (\$200.00)
- CLEAR LAND (\$100)¹
- WITHDRAW WATER (\$75.00 Annual Fee)^{2, 3, 4}

This permit applies to activities on the land owned by the LCWSC. I/We will abide by the attached plans and/or instructions pertaining to the construction for which this permit is applied. Additionally I/we will abide by all articles of the Lake Rabon User Policy, adopted January 24, 2006 by the LCWSC Board of Commissioners governing the uses of Lake Rabon. I/We understand that the Commission is not required to issue this permit and does so in the mutual interest in the welfare of Lake Rabon and the surrounding property. I/We understand that the LCWSC can instruct me/us to remove, relocate or make modifications to all work performed under this permit when necessary.

Complete this application and submit it with TWO (2) copies of PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS and a check to the LAURENS COUNTY WATER AND SEWER COMMISSION, PO BOX 1006, LAURENS, SC 29360. Allow ten working days for permit processing and approval.

Special Conditions

1. Do not cut trees 3 inches in diameter or larger. Do not disturb the land surface except as specifically approved by the LCWSC representative. Reseed all disturbed areas with approved grass seed. Use proper erosion control techniques to minimize sediment run-off into the Lake.
2. Electrical service to irrigation pumps must include a dedicated lockable disconnect accessible by LCWSC employees at all times.
3. The LCWSC will bill annually to withdrawal water; payment is due 15 business days from the bill date. Failure to make payment will result in electrical service for the irrigation pump to be locked at the disconnect. To reinstate this permit, applicant must reapply for a permit and pay all associated fees, including any additional unlock fees.
4. Home owners will be notified to restrict withdrawal of water during drought conditions at the discretion of the Executive Director and will be prohibited from withdrawal of water at any time the Drought Response Committee for the State of South Carolina determines that Laurens County is under a "Severe" or "Extreme" Drought as defined by the State Drought Response Committee criteria. Failure to abide by this notification will result in the electrical service for the irrigation pump to be locked at the disconnect. To reinstate this permit, applicant must reapply for a permit and pay all associated fees, including any additional unlock fees.
